PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES
JUNE 10, 2014

The opening prayer of the June 10, 2014 Greenwald Parish Council was led by Father Omar.

Members absent: Dale Winter.

President Sandy Niehoff asked for the past minutes to be read.

Minutes were read by secretary Betty Frieler and a motion was made by Veronica Inderrieden to accept the minutes as read and seconded by Joanie Van Beck.

Old Business: Sheryl Braun reported that the P.O. Box that the church had here in Greenwald will be closed since all correspondence goes to the office in Meire Grove. Betty Frieler made a motion to accept the closing of the P.O. box and Roger Schoenberg seconded it. No one had any comments on school issues at this time. Father reported that he felt everything at the cemetery looked in order, and if there were any questions we should ask someone on the cemetery committee. Maintenance issues were discussed next. Father requested to have only one mass and the cluster's Christian Women will take care of the reception.

Other items: Sandy then announced that Betty Frieler would be stepping down from the secretary job and nominated Veronica to take the position. Veronica accepted. The council thanked Betty for the good job she did as secretary.

Other items: The next Greenwald council meeting will be on Sept. 9 at 7:30 p.m. in the parish house unless we are told different. The parish house will serve as our new meeting place.
