

CHURCHES OF ST. JOHN AND ST. ANDREW
SCHOOL BUDGET, AND PARISH SUBSIDY MEETINGS
JUNE 9, 2014

The parish councils of St. John's and St. Andrew's parishes, SJSA school board, and teachers from SJSA School met on Monday, June 9, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. in the Greenwald church basement. Fr. Marv opened the meeting with a gospel reading.

Wanda Ahrens, school board president, presented those in attendance with the budget for the 2014-2015 school year. Brenda Nathe went through the figures and pointed out where changes had been made from the previous budget. The budget is balanced.

Wanda then passed out a SJSA Mission Statement and plans the school board had developed for the 2014-2015 school year. They plan to operate both buildings for the 2014-2015 school year and establish a planning committee to determine the direction of the school which will start immediately. The principal position has been filled and the school has received several promising applications for teachers. A key focus of the year will be to improve morale in the school and community and to begin plans for the 100-year celebration of Catholic education in our parishes.

The Parent and Parishioner Questionnaire filled out at the June 2 open meeting in Greenwald had been tabulated and the results were presented to the group for discussion.

Fr. Marv announced that St. John's funds that had been frozen by the diocese have been released. The Bishop would like the CD savings fund at the school be appropriated to the parishes. This fund can only be used for school needs.

Fr. Marv then asked the St. John and St. Andrews parish councils to split up to vote on whether to accept the amount of subsidy requested by the school from their parish.

The parish councils from St. John's and St. Andrew's parishes approved their subsidy to the school. Fr. Omar will announce at the weekend masses the decision to operate the school in both buildings for the 2014-2015 school year. A copy of the SJSA School Mission Statement and plans for the 2014-2015 school years will be handed out at the masses to parishioners this weekend. A copy will be mailed to parents with children attending the school.
